Y10 PROGRESS TRACKER 3: March 2024

We are pleased to inform you that a copy of your child's latest progress tracker is available to download to your computer or mobile device via the Satchel:One app or website. If you need help setting up your Satchel:One account, please refer to the letter from Mrs Vaughan on the school website ([News & Events / Letters Home](#)) or contact her in school. If you are unable to access your child's tracker via Satchel:One, please contact the school.

As Y10 students approach their summer examinations, their Attitude to Learning (A2L) takes on an even greater importance. A2L Grades for KS4 students focus on 'Developing Great Learning Habits' and range from D1 (lowest) to D5 (highest), describing the behaviours that enable exam success. Also included in this tracker are the results of your child's recent February trial examinations, end of course estimates and any barriers to learning your child may need to address to help achieve their potential this year.



Detailed information about why we use Attitude to Learning along with copies of the Attitude to Learning Grids and a short video explaining the importance of Attitude to Learning in Year 10 can be accessed via the school website ([Learning / Trackers, Reporting and A2L](#)), or by scanning or clicking on the QR code.

Your child's examinations in their one-year Vertical options and (for some) GCSE English Literature will clearly be a priority over the coming weeks. These are the actual final exams in these subjects and students must prepare carefully for them. After the end of the external GCSE, there will be a Y10 Assessment Week (w/c 24th June) when there will be internal trial examinations in subjects which continue into Y11. Further details about these exams will be shared in coming weeks.
