SPORTS DAY – TUESDAY 17TH JULY 2018.
VENUE - ENGLISH INSTITUTE OF SPORT

This year we are holding our Sports Day for students in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 on **Tuesday 17th July 2018** at The English Institute of Sport (EIS). This will be the final event of this year's inter-house competition and will incorporate basketball, netball and athletics. We would be delighted if it is possible for you to attend and support your child.

Sports Day is a school working day and all students are expected to attend this school event. It is of paramount importance that students conduct themselves in the correct manner when travelling to and from the event and whilst at the EIS. They are not only representing the school, but themselves and their family. Everyone must adhere to the strict health and safety rules which surround such an occasion. A programme outlining the order of events and procedures students should follow, whether competing or watching, is attached to this letter. **Students should bring this programme on the day.**

Pupils will need to make their own way to and from the venue. Wherever possible we advise that students travel to the event in pairs, making their own arrangements accordingly. In previous years many students have successfully used public transport.

The X1 bus can be caught at Arundel Gate and they run approximately every 10 minutes direct to the EIS. Students can also use the Supertram (Yellow Route) which stops at several places in Sheffield City Centre but they need to ensure that the Supertram is going along the route to Meadowhall. A map of the area around the EIS is on the reverse of this letter.

An alternative option would be travel to and from the EIS via coach from High Storrs. There would be a charge of £6 per student (cash or cheque) for this method of transport.

Upon arrival at the EIS students should register with their Form Tutor from 8.30am onwards and by 9.00am at the latest. We expect an early finish, approximately 2.45pm, which should allow students to return home at roughly the same time as usual. Once at the EIS, students will not be allowed to leave until after the presentation of the trophies and final registration.

Please complete and return the reply slip overleaf, if your child will require travel via coach from High Storrs School to and from the venue. This slip will need returning to School by Friday 29th June 2018 at the latest as travel by coach will only be possible if the reply slip is received before this date.

Bus:

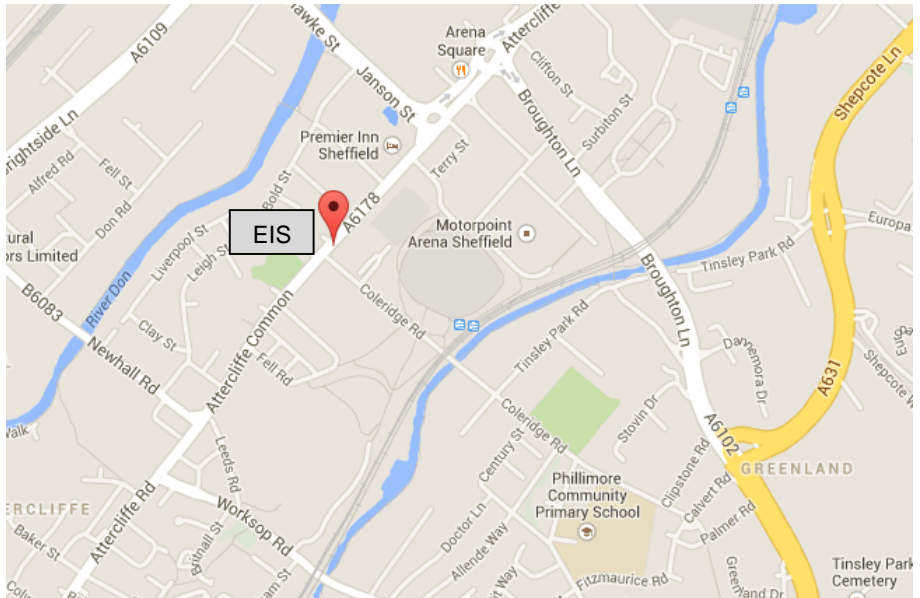
The number X1 bus route serves the EIS from Arundel Gate.
