**Parents of Y10 & Y11 Students**  
**Exam Preparation and 'Revision Booster' Sessions**

As you are aware, the exams are fast approaching! To further support our students we have put together a programme of 'revision booster' sessions that run until the end of the exam season.

These 'revision boosters' are COMPULSORY final preparation sessions where students will receive those important last minute prompts, reminders and top exam tips from teachers. Registers will be taken and we will follow up on any students missing from sessions. We appreciate this will mean some long school days for students, so we will be providing refreshments.

In a recent PSHCEE lesson your child used an overview of all sessions to prepare a personalised timetable of exams and booster sessions. Your child has his/her personal programme, but copies of the resources they used are attached to the email version of this letter for your information and to help you to support them at home. Copies of these materials are also posted on the MLE in the PSHCEE section that your child can access and on the website in the exams section. Your child may wish to use the electronic version to make a further, more detailed version for themselves. Please ensure the necessary arrangements are in place for your child all the relevant compulsory sessions.

We appreciate that this is a challenging time for students and so in addition to advice they've been receiving from subject teachers all year, during PSHCEE lessons we will be explaining a variety of revision techniques they can use as well as sharing tips on how to stay calm and focused.

Please also note the clear expectations of when Y11 students in particular are expected to attend lessons. Where they are not directed to be in school, they may undertake independent revision and preparation at home.
