Y12 PROGRESS TRACKER 3: March 2024

We are pleased to inform you that a copy of your child's latest progress tracker is available to download to your computer or mobile device via the Satchel:One app or website. If you need help setting up your Satchel:One account, please refer to the letter from Mrs Vaughan on the school website ([News & Events / Letters Home](#)) or contact her in school. If you are unable to access your child's tracker via Satchel:One, please contact the school.

Throughout Y12 and Y13, we consider Attitude to Learning (A2L) to be of critical importance. A2L Grades for Y12 & Y13 students focus on 'Mastering Great Learning Habits' and range from M1 (lowest) to M5 (highest), describing the behaviours that enable exam success. As they progress through Y12 and into Y13, it is your child's attitude to learning and learning behaviours that will make the greatest difference in their success at A Level / BTEC and beyond.



Detailed information about why we use Attitude to Learning along with copies of the Attitude to Learning Grids and a short video explaining the importance of Attitude to Learning in Year 12 can be accessed via the school website ([Learning / Trackers, Reporting and A2L](#)), or by scanning the QR code.

Alongside your child's target grades which were shared on Tracker 2, this tracker also includes end of course estimated grades for each of your child's examination courses. The estimates are based on a range of information including A2L, homework, classwork and internal tests and assessments. It is important that you and your child discuss these estimates in comparison to target grades, and that they work to improve in any subjects where the estimate may be below target. Where a student is below target, barriers to learning have been identified. Again, students should think carefully about how these barriers are affecting their progress, and speak to their class teachers about strategies for how to get back on track.

Please note that Y12 Parents' Evening will take place online on **Thursday 21st March 2024** (4.30pm-7.00pm) using the schoolcloud system. Appointments are now available to parents to book online and will close on Thursday 21st March at 12.00pm. Please refer to the letter from High Storrs shared last week regarding Y12 Parents' Evening.
