## **Enrolment**

Please ensure that you enrol in person on either Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> or Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> August between 9am and 3pm.

To enrol, please bring the original copy of your exam results (including exams taken in previous years) and your completed Enrolment Form, which is available for download from the school website [www.highstorrs.co.uk](http://www.highstorrs.co.uk). Click on the Sixth Form tab and select 'September 2019 Admission' from the drop down menu.

If you cannot attend enrolment, you must inform school and make separate arrangements to enrol, or you risk losing your place at High Storrs. If you have not enrolled by Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> August, or made alternative arrangements for enrolment, we will assume that you no longer require your place.

## **Bridging The Gap Work**

The step up between GCSE and A Level is significant. To help to prepare you for this, you will be set a compulsory piece of 'Bridging the Gap' work for each of your chosen subjects. This must be completed by the first day of term and handed in to your teachers for marking.
