

## **USING IMAGES OF CHILDREN CONSENT**

### **HIGH STORRS SCHOOL – Sixth Form 2019**

Occasionally, we may take photographs of the children at our school. These images may be used in a number of ways. To comply with the Data Protection Act 1998 and General Data Protection Regulation, which came into force 25 May 2018, we need your consent before we can photograph or make any recordings of your child. You may withdraw your consent at any time by informing the school in writing.

We may use these images in our school prospectus or in other printed publications that we produce, as well as on our website. We may also make DVD or webcam recordings in lessons and at special events like Sports Day or school trips. Photographs of students help us to record some of the exciting activities in which they participate: house events, charity events and sporting events, etc.

From time to time, our school may be visited by the media who will take photographs or film footage of a visiting dignitary or other high profile events. Students will often appear in these images, which may appear in local or national newspapers, or on televised news programmes.

Please indicate your consent on the sections below and return to school as soon as possible.

#### **Conditions of Use**

1. This form is valid for the duration of the time that your child attends High Storrs School.
2. We will not use the personal details or full names of any child or adult in a photographic image on video, on our website and social media, our digital communication screens or in any of our other printed publications.
3. We will not include personal email, postal addresses or telephone numbers on video, the school website and social media, our digital communication screens or in any other printed publications.
4. If we use photographs of individual students, we will not use the full name of that child in accompanying text or photo caption.
5. If we name a student in the text we will not use a photograph of that child to accompany the article.
6. We may include pictures of students and teachers that have been drawn by the students.
7. We may use group or class photographs or footage with very general labels, such as “a Science lesson” or “visiting the UCAS Fair”.
8. This consent can be withdrawn by parent or carer at any time by informing the school in writing.
