Dear Y13 Parents / Carers,

I am writing to you regarding the arrangements for the collection of A-Level / BTEC results in August.

All Y13 students who sat A-Levels / BTECs in the summer should be praised for their attitude and effort in completion of their examinations. Everyone did themselves proud and should be commended.

### **Collection of A-Level / BTEC Results – Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> August**

The school will open for the collection of A-Level / BTEC results from **8.00am on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> August**. Results will be collected from the Main Hall.

As well as celebrating results, we wish to support all Y13 students to find the right next step for them into the university or the Post 18 pathway of their choice. UCAS updates at 8.00am, showing whether your child has been accepted onto their firm (or insurance) choice university course. Clearing will also be open at this time should your child need or want to explore other courses with spaces for September 2024. Sixth Form staff will be available in school to support those students who may need advice and guidance on receipt of their examination results.

For Y13 students, results day is incredibly important. Many students will achieve the grades they need to accept their firm or insurance university offer. There can however be surprises where students achieve lower (or higher) grades than they were expecting, and may need support from members of staff to secure their next steps. It is important that students collect their results in person if possible.

### **What happens if a student is unavailable to collect their results**

If your child is unavailable to collect their results from school in person, they need to complete the attached form and return it to the school exams office no later than Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July.

The form provides two options. Your child can either nominate someone else to collect their results for them OR provide a stamped address envelope to have results posted home. We are not able, under ANY circumstances, to give results out over the phone, by text message or email.

Please note, the form should be completed by the student. Forms completed by anyone other than the student e.g. Parent/Carer, will not be accepted.

Each year, at least one student waits until results day to inform school that they cannot collect their results in person. If we do not have a completed form in place by the deadline, we will not be able to hand results to any other person on the day or post them out. Therefore, in order to avoid any disappointment when requests after the deadline cannot be met, please encourage your child to complete the form and return it by the 17<sup>th</sup> July.

### **Deletion of saved materials on the High Storrs School Network**


