We are pleased to inform you that a copy of your child's final Y7 progress tracker is available to download to your computer or mobile device via the Satchel:One app or website. If you are unable to access your child's tracker via Satchel:One, please contact the school.

At High Storrs, we consider Attitude to Learning to be of critical importance for building the foundations for student success, and this is the focus of reporting on your child's progress in Y7 and Y8. A2L Grades for Y7-8 students are entitled 'Building Great Learning Habits' and range from B1 (lowest) to B4 (highest). It is your child's approach to learning and learning behaviours that will make the greatest difference to their success as they move through school towards GCSEs, A-Levels and beyond.

Also available on the website are two short videos, one explaining why we use Attitude to Learning at High Storrs, and the other explaining the layout of your child's tracker and how to get the most from the information it contains.

Where gaps appear in the data, this is due to significant staff or student absence. This information will be made available at the earliest opportunity. Where a teacher's name is missing from your child's tracker, this indicates a rotation subject that does not currently appear on your child's timetable.
