RE: Permissions for High Storrs Hike

I am writing to you regarding arrangements for the High Storrs Hike which will take place during the summer term later this year. This event requires parental permission for students to take part.

High Storrs Hike – Friday 12th July 2024

The High Storrs Hike is our annual round walk from High Storrs for all students in years 7-10. The hike is a 13.5km walk around the Limb and Porter Valleys beginning and ending at school and take place during the normal school day. Student are expected to arrive at school at 8.35am as usual and will be dismissed at the end of their hike (which is usually before the normal end of the school day at 2.55pm).

Each student taking part is assigned to a small group of students with a member of staff, and there are other members of staff at regular intervals on route to ensure the safety of staff and students taking part. The walk should take most pupils around three to four hours to complete dependent on ability and weather.

The focus for the day is to get the students out in the fresh air for some physical activity and a chance for the school community to take part in a group activity together. We would also like to use the opportunity to raise a little money for the School Fund.
